

It has been an honor to serve as an at-large member of the Salt Lake County Council. As an at-large member, I work with County Mayor Jenny Wilson in serving the needs of the 1.2 million people who live in the 23 cities, metro townships and unincorporated areas within Salt Lake County.

In brief, your county government manages many county-wide functions. These include the jail, health department, criminal justice, elections, property records, 18 libraries, 6 golf courses, 19 recreation centers, dozens of parks and the Wheeler Historic Farm. Other county-wide services include the Eccles Theater, Capitol Theater, Abravanel Hall, Clark Planetarium, the Salt Palace, the Mountain America Expo Center and property tax administration. We provide meals on wheels and other services to seniors, to youth, to those needing behavioral health assistance, and to the homeless.

As your council member, I have worked hard to make sure your county tax dollars are spent wisely. I have fought for greater accountability and transparency on budgets and operations. I pressed for and was successful in getting performance audits initiated. I opposed two tax increases that I felt were not necessary and found \$36 million in cuts and efficiencies to offset the need for tax increases. I tripled the opportunities for citizens to speak at Council meetings to express their opinions and share their ideas.

It has been an honor to be a public servant and I feel I have made a real difference for the people of Salt Lake County. There is still more work to do, however. It is for this reason that I am seeking another term and am asking for your help. I am hopeful the people of Salt Lake County will recognize the work I have done and will support my reelection.

From Alta to West Jordan and from the Point of the Mountain to the State Capitol, it is expensive to campaign throughout Salt Lake County.
